FACTS: What does Midwest Community FCU Do With Your Personal Information?

WHY? Financial institutions choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice

carefully to understand what we do.

WHAT? The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include:

Social Security number and income

account balances and payment history

credit history and credit scores

When you are no longer our member, we continue to share your information as described in this notice.

HOW?

All financial institutions need to share members' personal information to run their everyday business. Inside this brochure, we list the reasons financial institutions can share their members' personal information; the reasons we choose to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.
